

Leeds City Council - Reset and Recovery from COVID

HOW WE TOOK ACTION

- 1. Staff training & development through 2021 with education partner CAWS
- 2. Soft Launch early December, focusing on two key populations:
- i. People deconditioned by COVID-19
- ii. Long-COVID
- 3. Current referral system
- 4. Partnership with Leeds Community Long-COVID Rehabilitation Service
- 5. 2022 Roadmap
- i. Train more staff to provide support in our centres to increase access
- ii. Collaboration with Leeds Community Long-COVID Rehabilitation Service & CAWS
- iii. to provide a pathway to physical activity. Including;
- Co-produced programme with referrals
- Mix of activities, hybrid model of face to face and digital
- Ongoing support with Active Leeds
- Recruiting from next 3 cohorts from LCT
