

It is large ask to shift a local economy to be more inclusive wellbeing focused is complicated.


- A place needs first to set its **vision** after a period of engaging with the local population

- Multiple ways through to inclusive wellbeing economies, what follows is structure and local to Yorkshire and Humber examples of where this is being worked on.


# Understand and use strategic levers

- Health is a core part of local economic plans and had some synergy with Health and Wellbeing Strategy.









- Engagement with communities about what they want from and Inclusive Wellbeing Economy


# Understand the impact of economics on future generations

Monitor the goals

- **ONS Subnational Wellbeing** tool for Comparing local authorities and the UK average by different indicators, such as weekly pay and healthy life expectancy.
- The Leeds Social Progress Index, helps measure how well Leeds is doing in terms of Inclusive Growth
- Yorkshire Vitality Index, coming soon produced in partnerships between the Yorkshire Councils and Universities
