






Health Protection CPD - Migrant Health

- Inclusion health groups very poor health outcomes, often much worse than the general population and a lower average age of death
- Experience significant stigma and discrimination which contributes considerably to increasing health inequalities
- Some migrant groups are more vulnerable to poor health which can relate to experiences in home country, their journey to safety and also once in the UK
- Current climate challenging asylum seekers Illegal Migration Act and implications, increased dispersed accommodation, large sites, hotel closures, streamlined asylum and homelessness, new Afghan arrivals

Across Y&H we have developed a structure to support improvements as well as some outputs ...








Immunisations for migrants in vulnerable circumstances
