Leeds Gambling Harm Vulnerability Matrix


We created a practical tool using high quality public health evidence to inform local decision making on gambling premises planning and licensing applications. The tool enables us to use our regulatory powers as a Local Authority to reduce gambling-related harms. This was a joint project of Public Health, Licensing, Financial Inclusion, and Planning, building on the Leeds Alcohol Licensing Data Matrix

Leeds identified high and moderate confidence evidence from OHID's "Risk factors for gambling and harmful gambling umbrella review", matching this to equivalent Leeds data sets, applying weighting based on the strength of the evidence. We took a cautious approach to defend our robust Licensing and Planning decisions from challenge. As more evidence emerges we will revisit the indicators

The Leeds Gambling Harms Vulnerability Matrix will be tested in real world decisions and iterated accordingly

The user inputs a **postcode**

This is linked to an MSOA and the data for that MSOA is displayed



e.g.

People: MSOA ranks 39th, Medium category

Place: MSOA ranks 10th, High category

The user can see indicator detail, compare their MSOA to others, and see the results mapped People and Places categories are used because this is how Planning assess applications








