

## Our Purpose

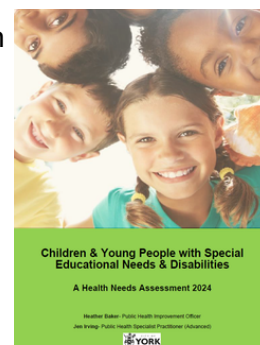
The York Population Health Hub (PHH) is a multi-organisation group bringing colleagues from health, public health, and business intelligence to undertake projects using population health management processes.

Our purpose is to better understand patient populations, the factors that drive their health status, and support the re-design of care for “at risk” groups.

We aim to reduce health inequalities, and make health and care services more sustainable.

## What we have achieved

- Increased hypertension detection rates by installing health kiosks in various public venues in York
- Supported proactive social prescribing services to improve the health and wellbeing of people with respiratory conditions in the community
- Initiated a Waiting Well project to provide resources and support for people awaiting certain surgical procedures such as joint replacements
- Publish health needs assessments for various cohorts including children & young people with SEND, Gypsy & Traveller communities
- Ran an analysis on the Health Impacts of increased cost of living
- Published Core20PLUS5 reports into vulnerable adults and children
- Quarterly Lunch & Learn sessions



## Key Responsibilities

### Enabling

Supports the York Health & Care Partnership (YHCP) to access and use population health data and apply population health management to their work.

### Analysing

Improves the JSNA to make it useful and for it to be used. It improves analysis materials and ensures they are widely used across the YHCP.

### Doing

Leads tangible PHM projects which show the benefit of this approach and improve population health outcomes.
