Before the programme

Medical applicants

- Minimum of **2 years of postgraduate medical experience** by time of appointment (equivalent to that obtained in a UK Foundation Training Programme)

Non-medical applicants

- At least 60 months (wte) work experience at time of appointment, of which at least **24 months (wte) must be in an area relevant to population health practice** at Band 6 or above (or equivalent)

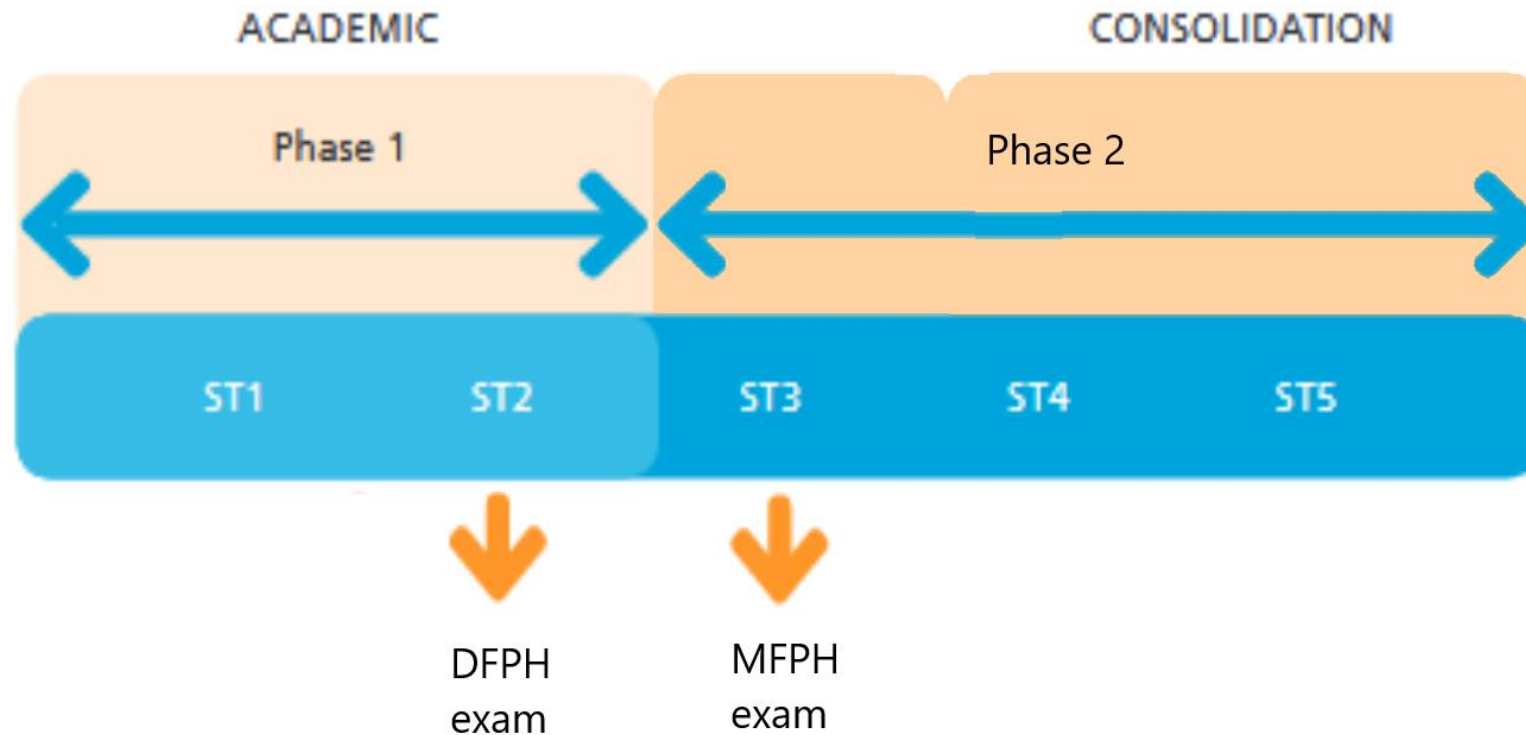
