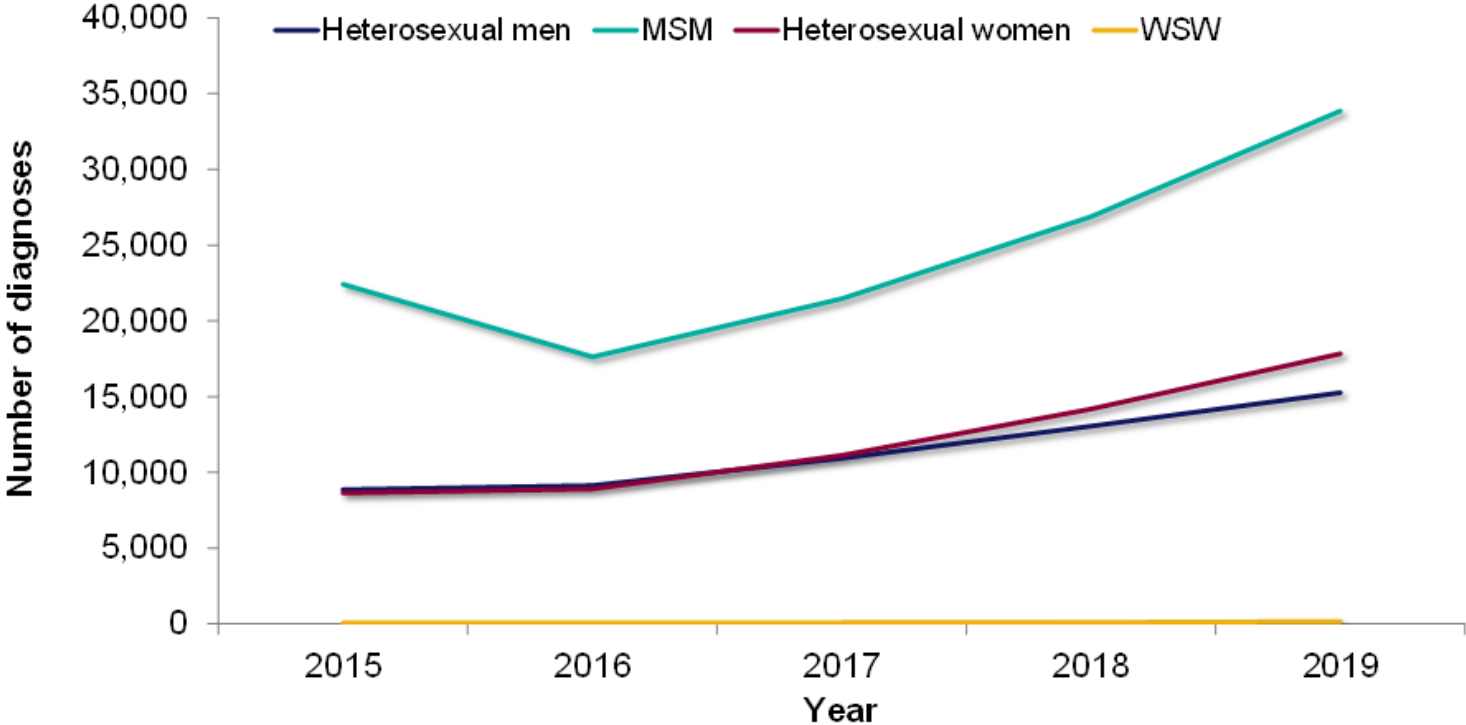

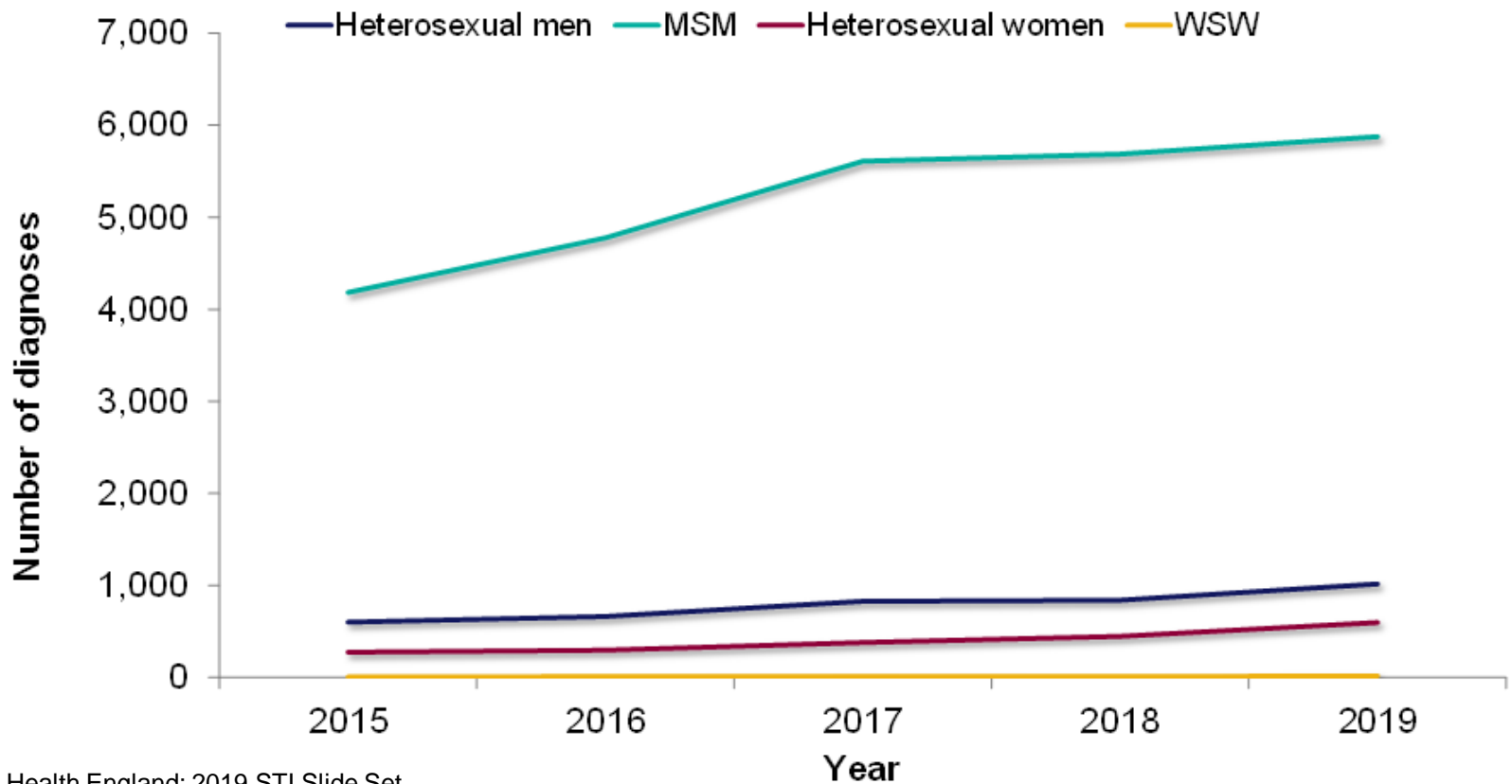
Number of gonorrhoea diagnoses by sexual risk:

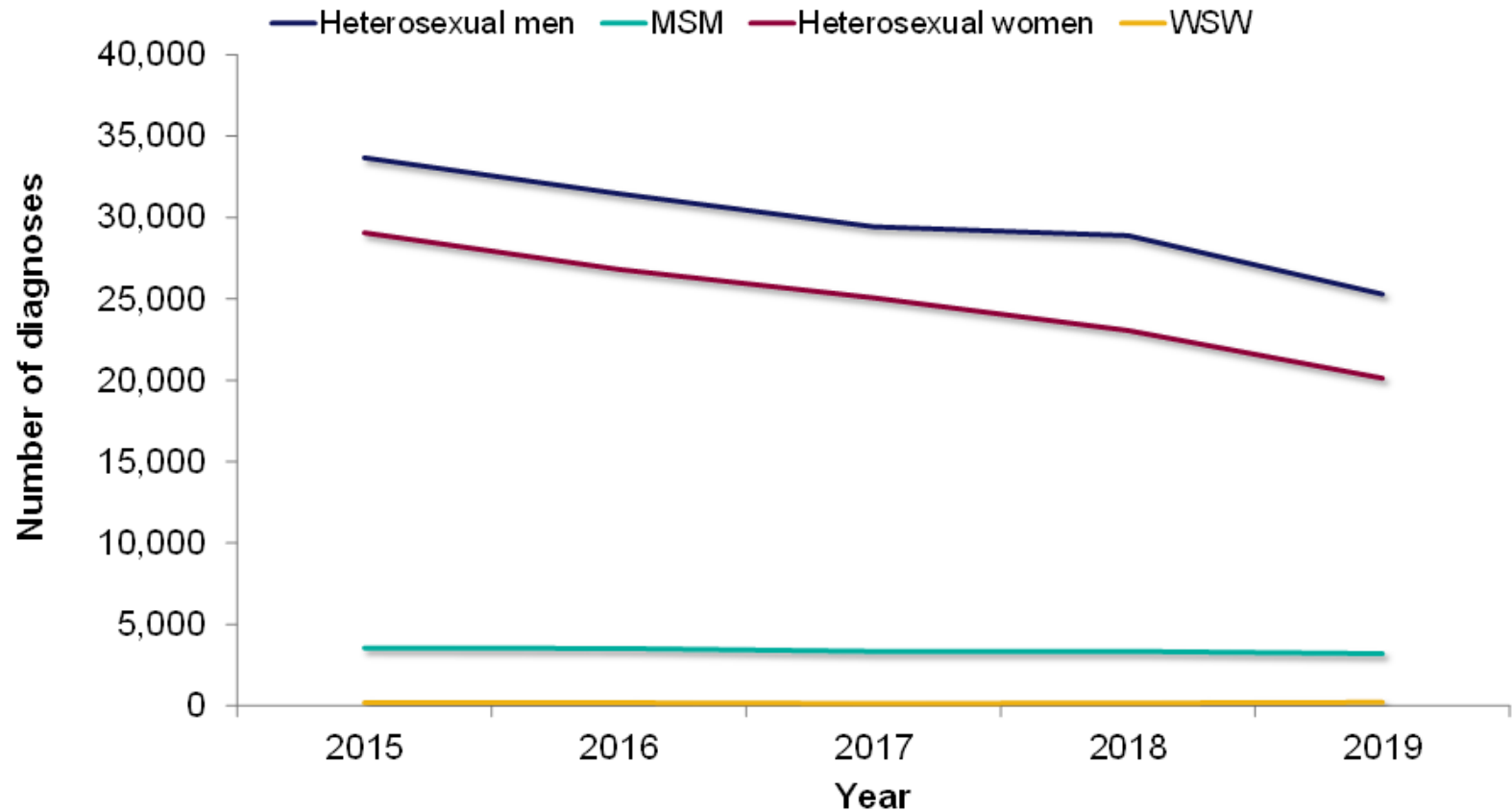
Number of syphilis (primary, secondary and early latent) diagnoses by sexual risk: England, 2015 to 2019

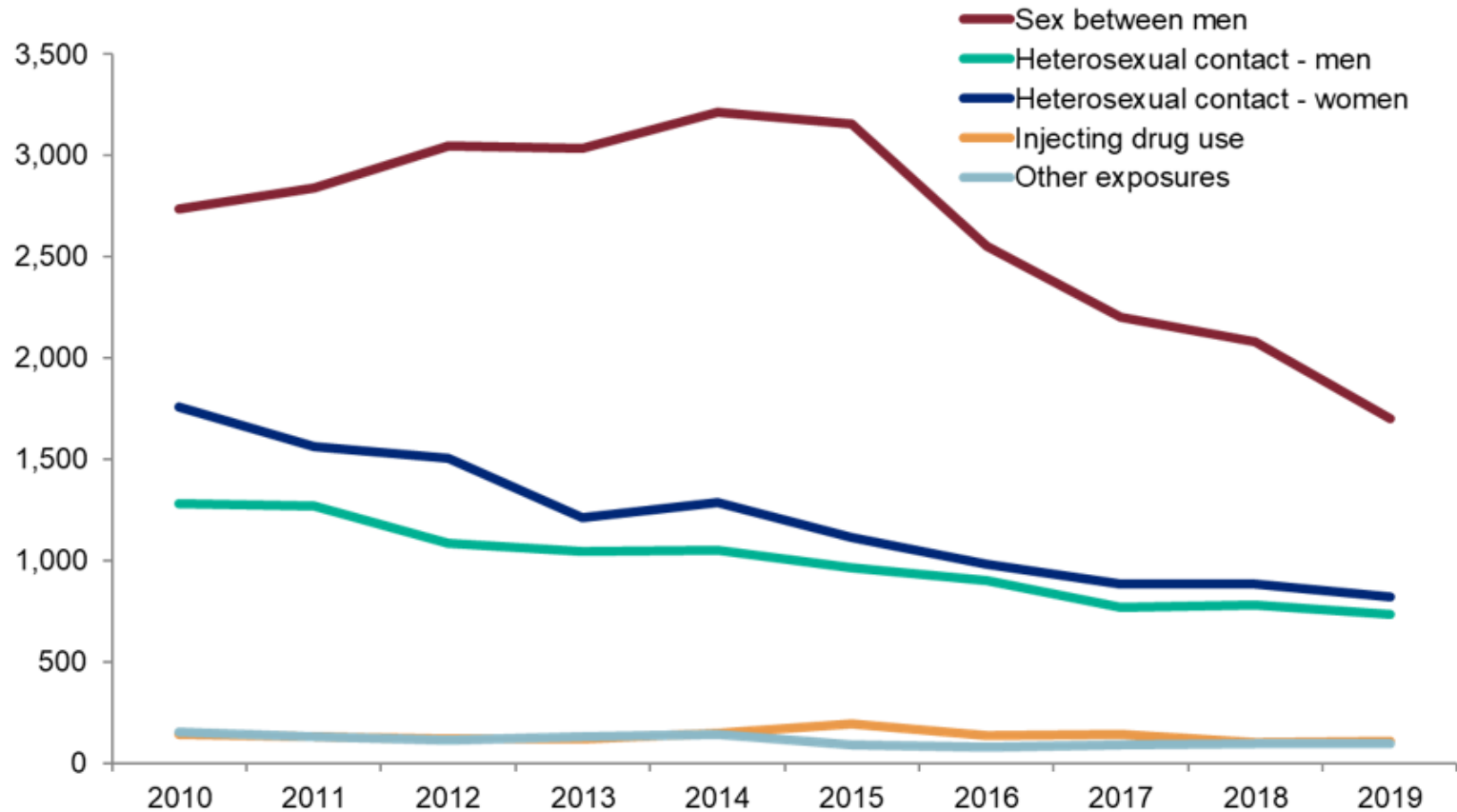
Number of anogenital warts (first episode) diagnoses by sexual risk: England, 2015 to 2019

## But.....

- STI data is from specialist & non-specialist SH services i.e. only those that have accessed these services
- Relies on 'sexual risk' being accurate – both what the service user tells the clinician and what the clinician asks and records
